The comments arrived in the midst of a flurry of Obamacare-related statements from the White House, amid continued uncertainty among House Republicans and within the GOP over whether their party will be able to repeal and replace the health care law. Trump -- at a rally in Huntsville, Alabama -- offered a mixed message. "You are going to lose your insurance, but it's going to be a much better health care," he said. "The Democrats are working so hard to kill your plan. They can't do it, they are doing everything they can to obstruct, delay, resist, anything they can do so that you don't have a plan, but it's a great plan. It's a brilliant plan and we're going to win." Later, in a question-and-answer session with supporters, he continued: "It would be great if we can get a great plan, great healthcare. Would be a great thing. It's going to happen. It is going to happen. A lot of the Republicans are really opposed to it.... We're being obstructionists. We're being obstructionists."
